## NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS

**ENTRY FEES** shall **not** be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or weather emergencies or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, **no** refund of entry fees will be made.

**REFUND OF ENTRY FEES** minus \$3.00 handling fee for bitches entered in Rally and/or Obedience that come in season after closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Trial Secretary. This certificate must be postmarked before the opening day of the show or given to the Trial Secretary before the start of the show.

**DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

**JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT** for any dog holding up a class. Owners and agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

**ALL DOGS PRESENT** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

**NO DOG** may be permanently removed from the show before it is judged except by consent of the Trial Secretary upon a Veterinarian's recommendation of removal.

**OBEDIENCE AND RALLY CLASSES**, all dogs will be judged from low to high jump height for all trials, beginning with dogs whose jump height is 4 inches. Move-ups will be permitted in Rally.

**From Points North:** Take Rt. 95 south to exit 140 (Va 630) Stafford. At light turn left onto Va 630- Courthouse Rd. Go approximately 1 mile to US Rt 1. Take a right onto Rt 1 and go about 2.2 miles. At light turn left onto Eskimo Hill Rd (Va 628) and look to make an almost immediate left onto Big Spring Lane at the bend in the road. The road will be gravel. Go about 1/10th of a mile- the road will fork. Stay to the right and Colonial K9 will be on your left side.

**From Points South:** Take Rt. 95 north to exit 136 Centreport Parkway exit (Stafford Airport) towards US Rt 1. Turn right onto Centreport Pkwy and go approximately 3/4ths of a mile to US Rt 1. Take a right onto Rt 1 and go about 2.5 miles. At light, turn right onto Eskimo Hill Rd (Va 628) and look to make an almost immediate left onto Big Spring Lane at the bend in the road. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
